Visiting Locomotives on public running days.

Signing In

A visiting locomotive must have signed in & unloaded before running starts.

The visitors form must be completed & signed by visiting locomotive driver.

If a locomotive is to be driven by more than one visiting driver then both drivers must complete separate visitors forms.

Club members signing in a visiting locomotive MUST check that the visitor has,

- 1 – Signed in on the track log book.
- 2 – Filled in & signed the visiting locomotive form, answering all questions.
- 3 – Check all documents, ie boiler/insurance certificates & club membership card.
(all documents must be originals no photocopies)
- 4 – Give the visitor a track information sheet.
- 5 – When the form is completed it must be sealed in the envelope provided & the visitor's full name printed on the outside of the envelope. Ensure that this completed envelope is conveyed to the secretary to be kept in the societies records.
- 6 – Loan the visitor a high visibility jacket.

A visitor will be refused access to the track if :-

If the visitor refuses to answer all the questions & sign the visitor form.

If the visitor is not a current member of a United Kingdom club or society.

If the visitor does not have all the correct original documents ie insurance, boiler certificate & club membership card. (no photocopies)

The locomotive is not owned by the visitor (unless accompanied by the owner who is also the driving the locomotive)

If the visitor has less than three months experience of driving this locomotive.

Visitors locomotive (if steam) is not fitted with a working spark arrester.

Visitors locomotive is not fitted with a working whistle or horn.

The visitor is barred from holding a United Kingdom driving license because of ill health.

The visitor appears to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
